Boulevard Tree Program

Growing Friends has planted trees in the boulevards between the sidewalk and the street all over town, including both the older sections and the newer subdivisions. The program began in 1994, when Growing Friends received a start-up grant from the U.S. Forest Service. The program has evolved over the years in many ways. For example, in 1996 (Hauser Blvd.), 2002 (Barney Addition), and 2009 (Walnut Street) Growing Friends sponsored plantings that involved a larger number of trees in one area. The number of trees reported below does not include replacement plantings from previous years. The dollar amounts spent each year vary due the cost of the trees, the fact that certain species cost more, and whether the trees were purchased in the Spring or the Fall. Growing Friends asks that the property owner/homeowner contribute roughly one-third the cost of the trees, help dig the hole, and water and maintain the trees.

Ongoing Activities

Memorial Trees. Growing Friends will match up to \$150 for the planting of a memorial tree

in for a family member or friend. The planting must be in a publicly owned space. Cumulative total (and growing): \$1,920.

Arbor Day. Growing Friends organizes a tree planting, usually at an elementary school, to celebrate Arbor Day. Cumulative total (and growing): \$946.

Habitat for Humanity Houses. Growing Friends has a standing offer of up to \$300 to help fund the landscaping of new HfH homes, with the understanding that at least one tree will be planted. Cumulative total (and growing): \$1,008.

Rocky Mountain Development Council Houses. Growing Friends has a standing offer of up to \$500 to help fund the landscaping of new RMDC student built homes, with the understanding that at least one tree will be planted. Cumulative total (and growing): \$2,150.
